Qualifications

1. be a DECA member at the national level
2. be a senior
3. have an overall cumulative grade point average of 3.2 for the seven previous semesters (with 4.0 being equal to an A)
4. participate in at least three of the areas listed under DECA activities, leadership and community/school activities

Procedures

- Completed applications must be received by DECA Inc. no later than *February 1, 2010*.
- A copy of the *official DECA roster* must accompany the application to verify that the applicant is a DECA member at the national level.
- An application fee of **\$5.00** must accompany the application.
- An Honor Award certificate will be mailed directly to you with suggestions for appropriate presentation and recognition.
