13. How will you generate enthusiasm in members in North Dakota?
14. What are your goals in running for office?
15. Why did you run for this office instead of for state president?
16. If you have 1 hour left to live, what would you do?
17. How will you work with other team members?
18. What personal or school obligations (activities, sports) are you involved in that will hinder your performance as a state officer?
19. If you could choose the theme for next year's state conference, what would it be?
